It is important for students transferring credit to Clarkson College to submit a final official transcript after completing all course work from other institutions. Students must receive a grade of “C-” or higher to be considered for transfer credit. Clarkson College does not accept transfer credit for courses taken after enrollment at Clarkson College.

Elective Credit

Bachelor’s degree: An additional 41-50 credit hours may be transferred in as elective credit to Clarkson College.

Residency Requirement
