Clarkson College accepts transfer credit from Eastern Iowa Community College. The articulation agreement shows how courses completed at Eastern Iowa Community College will be transferred to Clarkson College. It is important for students transferring credit to Clarkson College to submit a final official transcript after completing all course work from other institutions. Students must receive a grade of “C-” or higher to be considered for transfer credit. Clarkson College does not accept transfer credit for courses taken after enrollment at Clarkson College.

**All courses are also offered at Clarkson College and are not necessary for admission.**

There are two program options (traditional and transfer) for the Associate of Science in Physical Therapist Assistant degree.

**Traditional Option (6 semesters):** All courses may be taken at Clarkson College or equivalent from an accredited institution and are not necessary for application.

**Transfer Option (4 semesters):** Must have the following courses from an accredited institution with a transfer grade of a “C” or higher completed.

**And one of the following:**

Associate’s or higher level degree from a regionally accredited institution of higher education

**or**

A minimum of 17 additional credit hours at an accredited institution with a transfer grade of a “C” or higher

**Residency Requirement**

Associate’s degree: At least 40 semester hours must be completed at Clarkson College for an associate’s degree.
