Candidates and Those Admitted and Going Through the Registration Process

The Clarkson College Nurse Anesthesia Program requires applicants and those admitted and going through the registration process to notify the Director of Enrollment & Advising within 48 hours of any of the following:

Dismissal, termination, or placement on a not-for-hire list in any health care facility

Registered Nurse or Advanced Practice Registered Nurse license revoked, restricted, suspended or limited by state, surrendered, or the subject of a pending action or investigation

Subject of a disciplinary action, placed on probation, suspended or dismissed from an educational program for unethical behavior, questions of academic integrity or any other reason

Previous attendance at another nurse anesthesia program

Conviction of a misdemeanor or felony or have any pending charges

Failure to disclose any of the above may result in withdrawal of the offer of admission or dismissal from the Clarkson College Nurse Anesthesia Program.

Students

The Clarkson College Nurse Anesthesia Program requires students to notify the Nurse Anesthesia Program Director within 48 hours any of the following:

Dismissal, termination, or placement on a not-for-hire list in any health care facility

Registered Nurse or Advanced Practice Registered Nurse license revoked, restricted, suspended or limited by state, surrendered, or the subject of a pending action or investigation

Conviction of a misdemeanor or felony or have any pending charges

Failure to disclose any of the above may result in probation or dismissal from the Clarkson College Nurse Anesthesia Program.
