

## **Sequenced Program Progression**

### **Policy**

The Nurse Anesthesia Program is a lock step, sequenced program where each new semester builds upon the previous semesters. Prerequisite course work must be successfully completed before beginning the next higher level of course work. Students in the Nurse Anesthesia Program must successfully complete all courses in sequence as outlined in the program layout. Students in the Nurse Anesthesia Program must successfully complete all courses in a semester before beginning the next semester. Courses in the Didactic Phase, Phase I, must be completed before beginning the Clinical Phase, Phase II. Students in the Nurse Anesthesia Program must complete all courses outlined in the degree plan, in the sequenced order.
