Clarkson College has signed an articulation agreement with Western Nebraska Community College (WNCC). Students who complete an approved associate degree at WNCC are guaranteed general admission into a corresponding baccalaureate degree program at Clarkson College.

By completing the Associate of Arts (AA), Associate of Science (AS), or Associate of Applied Science (AAS) at WNCC, students transfer 60 semester hours as a direct transfer package into the Bachelor of Science in Health Information Administration degree at Clarkson College. The following degree plan outlines the courses needed to complete this degree. The Bachelor of Science in Health Information Administration degree may be completed 100% online in as little as 4 semesters.
