

## Student Employment

### Policy

The nurse anesthesia resident may not participate in any employment as a nurse anesthetist by title or function or receive payment for nurse anesthesia services during the duration of the anesthesia nursing program. To do so will result in immediate dismissal.

Outside employment is discouraged due to the program's intense nature.

A resident may work, with the written consent of the Program Director, when:

- It does not interfere with the educational program
- Academic and clinical performance is satisfactory
- The resident is not employed during the 16 hours prior to any class or clinical assignment/activity
- The resident does not miss class, clinical assignments/activities, or other professional activities such as conferences and meetings
