# Associate of Science or Bachelor of Science in Physical Therapist Assistant

Clarkson College accepts transfer credit from Mid-Plains Community College. The articulation agreement shows how courses completed at Mid-Plains Community College will be transferred to Clarkson College. It is important for students transferring credit to Clarkson College to submit a final official transcript after completing all course work from other institutions. Students must receive a grade of “C-” or higher to be considered for transfer credit. Clarkson College does not accept transfer credit for courses taken after enrollment at Clarkson College.

**All courses are offered at Clarkson College and not necessary for admission.**

There are two program options (traditional and transfer) for the Associate of Science in Physical Therapist Assistant degree.

- **Traditional Option (6 semesters):** All courses may be taken at Clarkson College or equivalent from an accredited institution and are not necessary for application.
- **Transfer Option (4 semesters):** Must have the following courses from an accredited institution with a transfer grade of a “C” or higher completed: Human Anatomy with lab (4), Human Physiology with lab (4), English Composition I (3), Medical Terminology (1), College Algebra (3), Introduction to Psychology (3).

**And one of the following:**

Associate’s or higher level degree from a regionally accredited institution of higher education

**or**

A minimum of 17 additional credit hours at an accredited institution with a transfer grade of a “C” or higher

### Residency Requirement

Associate’s degree: At least 40 semester hours must be completed at Clarkson College for an associate’s degree.

Bachelor’s degree: At least 27 semester hours must be completed at Clarkson College for a bachelor’s degree.
