Clarkson College accepts transfer credit from Western Nebraska Community College. The articulation agreement shows how courses completed at Western Nebraska Community College will be transferred to Clarkson College. It is important for students transferring credit to Clarkson College to submit a final official transcript after completing all course work from other institutions. Students must receive a grade of "C-" or higher to be considered for transfer credit. Clarkson College does not accept transfer credit for courses taken after enrollment at Clarkson College.

Associate's Degree 2 + 2 Option:

If you are entering the program with an Associate's degree or higher from an accredited institution, you will be able to transfer in a minimum of 54 credit hours and can complete the Bachelor's degree in as few as three semesters.

All courses are also offered at Clarkson College and are not necessary for admission.
